



INDIAN HARBOUR BEACH CITY PARKS

W. LANSING GLEASON PARK

Gleason Park is located approximately ½ mile north of the Eau Gallie Causeway, at the corner of South Patrick Drive and Yacht Club Blvd. The beautiful 27-acre park offers a competition-size swimming pool, volleyball, shuffleboard, horse shoes, an exercise trail, picnic facilities, playground, and plenty of Florida wildlife. Facilities available for rental in Gleason Park are as follows:

- (1) North Pavilion
- (2) Pavilion by boardwalk
- (3) Picnic tables by playground
- (4) Picnic tables by volleyball court

BICENTENNIAL BEACH PARK & MILLENNIUM BEACH PARK

Bicentennial Beach Park is located just north of Pinetree Drive & Millennium Beach Park is located just south of Atlantic Boulevard on Hwy A1A in Indian Harbour Beach. Aside from our lovely beach, the parks offer picnic facilities, restroom facilities, a volley ball court at Bicentennial, and a playground at Millennium. The large pavilions are available for rental. Small pavilions are open to the general public on a first come, first serve basis.

- ❖ Renter must live within the City Limits of Indian Harbour Beach to be eligible for the Resident Rate.

RULES & REGULATIONS

- Maximum occupancy/attendance for park rentals: 40 people
- It is your responsibility to obtain a receipt and a reserved sign from the Indian Harbour Beach Recreation Center. If other members of the community are utilizing the facility upon your arrival, it is your responsibility to present your receipt and reserved sign to gain control of the facility. If any conflicts or problems arise, you may contact the Indian Harbour Beach Police Department's non-emergency line: 773-3030
- You may only utilize the facility for the hours specified in your letter requesting usage. Other functions may be scheduled before or after yours.
- Park hours are dawn to 10:00 p.m.
- There is an additional fee of \$10 to use electricity in the park.
- Special permission must be obtained to bring outside equipment into the parks.

PARK RENTAL PROCEDURE

- (1) Make reservations at the Indian Harbour Beach Community Services Office. Office hours are M-F, 9 a.m. – 5 p.m.
- (2) Turn in Letter Requesting Usage (see Pol. & Rules page 4 for format) and Rental Fee within 10 days.
- (3) Pick up reserved sign and receipt from Indian Harbour Beach Recreation Center's Office to take to the park with you on rental date.
